low-prep & low-mess.
Mix and match to create
tons of easy crafts

- ☐ Empty toilet paper rolls
- ☐ Toddler-safe scissors
- ☐ Jumbo crayons or washable markers
- ☐ Glue stick + washable glue
- ☐ Pre-cut shapes or colorful scrap paper
- ☐ Googly eyes (peel-and-stick preferred!)
- ☐ Pom-poms and pipe cleaners
- ☐ Yarn or ribbon scraps
- ☐ Cotton balls or sponge pieces
- ☐ Paper plates and paper bags
- ☐ Stickers (theme or letter sets)
- ☐ Washi tape (fun and low mess)
- ☐ Mini clothespins (great for fine motor skills)
- ☐ Seasonal cutouts (hearts, leaves, snowflakes)
- ☐ Coloured construction paper
- ☐ Playdough

6 Easy Craft Ideas

1

Stickers Tracing

Draw lines and shapes on a sheet of construction paper. Give it to your toddler and a bunch of stickers to stick along the lines

2

Holes threading

Punch several holes in a paper plate. Give your child a yarn (taped at the end) and let them thread the plate until there are no holes left to thread.

3

Colour sorting fun

Paint four toilet paper rolls - red, blue, orange, pink and glue them vertically on to a cardboard or carton. Give the glued rolls and coloured pompoms to your toddler to sort colours.

4

Pompoms & clothespin paint fun

Draw a picture on a cardboard paper. Give some paint and pompoms pinned to a clothespin to your toddler. Let them paint the picture using the pompom and the clothespin.

5

Bud picking

Punch holes in a paper plate. Stick cotton buds in them. Give the cotton bud plate and some clothespins or mini tongs to your toddler. Let your toddler have fun picking out each bud.

6

POPSICLE STICKS PUZZLE

Put 6 - 10 jumbo popsicle sticks together. Hold them together and draw a picture on them. Scatter the popsicle sticks and give them to your child to put together and reveal the picture.
